CONSIDERATIONS

COVID-19 policies are intended to mitigate, not eliminate, risk. No single action or set of actions will completely eliminate the risk of COVID transmission, but implementation of several coordinated interventions can greatly reduce that risk.

We currently, and will continue to, follow guidelines from Lyon County Public Health, MDE, the MDH, and the CDC.

Our plan is subject to change based on updated guidance.

REQUIRED PRACTICES

All instruction will be Face to Face

- Social Distance as much as possible; keep seating charts
- Masks encouraged indoors, especially for anyone who has not been vaccinated
- Build Routines for Hygiene Practices
- Daily cleaning of high touch surfaces
- Limit non-essential visitors/volunteers/external groups

Health Checks

- Families will be responsible for daily health checks for their children
- Staff will be responsible for their own checks
- Stay home if temperature of 100.4 or higher, experiencing symptoms, or positive test of COVID.
- Stay home if household member has tested positive for COVID for 14 days from last exposure.
- Notify school nurse of any symptoms or positive tests within the household.

Visitors

- Limit non-essential visitors and visits.
- Anyone entering the school building will need to complete visitor screening questions, including a temperature check, wear a mask (self-provided or available at each office), and sign in using our visitor management system.

If there is a confirmed positive within a classroom

- The nurse will notify family of each student in the class.
- Encourage testing for all after 5 days last exposure.
- Contact trace as needed.
- Close contacts mask until negative test or up to 10 days.
- Any other student who develops symptoms would be asked to quarantine for up to 10 days.

Ventilation

- Increased circulation of outside air into buildings

Communal Spaces

- Staggered use
- Increased cleaning protocols

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Increased daily protocols

Hand Hygiene

- Teach and reinforce
- Strategic signage placement

Shared Objects

- Individual supplies

RESPONDING TO CONFIRMED CASES

- Close contacts of students or staff who have tested positive with COVID-19 will be notified by of the potential exposure.
- Testing after 5 days of contact is encouraged even if not showing symptoms.
- Close contacts will be asked to mask until they receive a negative test result or up to 10 days from the last exposure.
- Any other student who develops symptoms is asked to quarantine for up to 10 days.
- No quarantine is necessary if fully vaccinated. (work with nurse for details)

TESTING SCENARIOS AND THRESHOLDS

- Close contacts are defined as someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 48 hours before illness onset until the time the patient is isolated.
