RE: ACTIVITIES DURING DISTANCE LEARNING

Marshall Public Schools' Administration announced that beginning on Wednesday, November 11, 2020, the district will move to a Distance Learning model.

This move will also impact MPS activities in several ways:

1. Varsity volleyball and football will be allowed to finish their season as scheduled at this time. Those teams will be allowed to continue to practice in person and compete, including through their post-season.
2. Effective Wednesday, November 11, all fall sports (volleyball and football) will discontinue all non-varsity level practice and competition. Coaches at those lower levels would be welcome (and encouraged) to remain in virtual contact with student-athletes during the distance learning phase, but there will be no further in-person practices or contests for lower levels after Tuesday.
3. Winter sports/activities at all levels that are scheduled to begin during the planned distance learning phase will not be allowed to begin in-person. Only virtual contact/coaching will be allowed to take place until further notice.
4. Other activities that are currently taking place virtually (i.e. Math Team, BPA, or Knowledge Bowl) can continue to do so virtual if possible. However, there should be no in person meetings at the school or anywhere else.
