



MARSHALL TIGER SPRING 2021 SPORTS SPECTATOR ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

Marshall Public Schools, in compliance with the current Minnesota Department of Health, Minnesota Department of Education, Big South Conference policies and the MSHSL recommendations will implement the following process for spectator attendance at all Marshall Tiger spring sports.

1. Marshall Public Schools will NOT be charging admission to any spring sporting events or contests.
2. Spectators at all MSHSL activities continue to be required to wear a mask or face covering.
3. Spectators are to remain socially distant (minimum of six feet apart). Please feel free to bring your lawn chair or blanket and spread out down the foul lines at a ball game.
4. Spectators are not to mix with the players before, during, or after the contests. Players and spectators are to remain at least 12 feet apart.
5. For MDH contacting tracing records, spectators are required to register for attendance at all events/contests.
6. Marshall Public Schools will provide a short, simple online registration link for each of our spring contests. This link can be found on the Activities Calendar by clicking the “tix” icon.
