If you always wanted to learn how to skate or need help with developing your skating skills, the Southwest Figure Skating Club (SWFSC) along with Marshall Community Services (MCS) will be putting on the Learn to Skate program, starting 10/15/22 at the Red Baron Arena and Expo.

The Learn to Skate Program is designed by the United States Figure Skating Association (USFSA). This is a beginning ice skating program that is fun, challenging and rewarding. Students are encouraged to bring their own skates, or skate rentals are available for \$3 per rental. Single blades required for all skaters. helmets recommended, especially for young skaters.

The cost of the program is \$40/student.

Basic Skills 1-6: The “Basic Skills” are fundamentals of the sport. These six levels of the program introduce the fundamental moves, forward skating, backward skating, crossovers, turns, edges, etc....
