We are happy to share that we will be closing soon on our newest property located at 900 Hwy 59 N. After the closing a team will begin discussing building renovations and construction timelines. The goal is to have the doors open and ready for students Fall 2022. The new facility will host the new automotive programming, along with the current welding and CNA programs to move over there as the space becomes ready. The location will allow plenty of room for expansion for future programming. Our district is very fortunate to have this opportunity and we are grateful for the community partners that support this new initiative.





- Total of 4 existing buildings.
- Building 1 will serve as the primary academic space.
 - The south end of this building has 2 stories and is not accessible. It also has apparent water damage the needs extensive repair.
 - We plan to remove the south end of this building and rebuild that end to serve as classroom space.
 - The north side of building 1 is a more recent addition. It will house the welding and auto shop spaces.
- Building 2 is older and will not meet code requirements for a school. It will likely need to be taken down.
- Building 3 will serve as storage for the welding and autos programs.
- Building 4 will be cold storage for now; it eventually could house a construction trades lab space when the weather permits.
- The property we are purchasing runs back to the railroad right-of-way.
- The location will allow plenty of room for expansion for future programming.
- CNA, Welding, and Autos will be the first classes to open at this site; we're hoping to start classes next fall.
