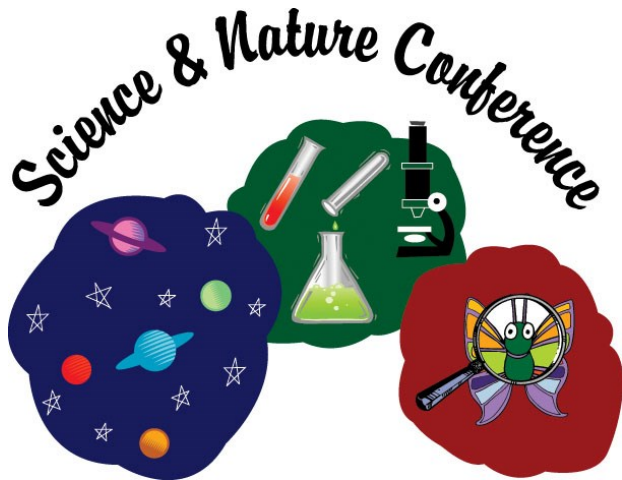


SWWC Service Cooperative presents the 25th Annual
